Why we do what we do

A Comprehensive Physical Exam is the best assurance that your kitten is happy, healthy, and looking forward to all of its nine lives. It is also the time to pick up on, and treat, damaging parasitic infections such as worms or giardia, as well as protect your new kitten from infectious disease through vaccination.

And because we take a holistic approach at Schulhof Animal Hospital, we like to spread out vaccine visits to allow your kitten's immature immune system to

adequately respond and recover from the vaccine challenge.

Extra visits also give you time to ask all the

questions that come to mind, and give us the chance to become acquainted with you and your kitten.

What pets are eligible?

Kittens to six months of age are eligible to participate in the Kitten WellCare Plan. Spay or neuter surgery must be completed prior to the pet's six month anniversary.

What about spaying or neutering?

Spaying prevents unwanted kittens, and neutering helps prevent male cats from urine marking. At SAH, we use sterile technique, pre-anesthetic, an intravenous catheter for fluids and safety's sake, as well as gas anesthesia, electronic monitoring, and pain medication just as is done in human hospitals.

What does it Cost?

Because we are dedicated to the well-being of your pet, and believe that preventative care is the best care, the Kitten WellCare Plan is a wonderful value providing a 50% savings from our regular service fees.

The package is priced in two affordable installments, one at enrollment before your first visit, and one prior to your kitten's spay or neuter surgery.

What's not covered?

Unlisted vaccines, tests, and medications, flea and tick preventative, de-clawing, pre-anesthetic blood work, radiography, ECG's and the treatment of congenital or medical problems other than round and hook worms are not covered under the Kitten WellCare Plan.
